How can you be a part of Oktoberfest-

- Facilities- The commons and gym are transformed by this team.
- **Food-** This team coordinates the food and desserts for the event.
- Bar- Beer, Wine, Soda and Water are sold at the event.
- **Decorations-**Work to transform the commons and gym into a fall fest.
- Auction, E-Auction & Redemption- Procurement of over 200 items, organize procured items into themed packages, pictures of items, posting of the items to be sold on the e-commerce site. Redemption: final payment and passing out the items to the winners.
- **Harvest Club** Procurement of bottles of wine, cookies, and gift cards for the winning prizes.
- **Volunteer Coordinator-** Recruit, schedule and educate the volunteers for the overall event
- **Oktoberfeast-** This is part of the Oktoberfest event that the students participate in. Coordinate a hot lunch and tshirt for the students.
