




# 1st Grade creates Sunflowers explaining what we learned about our heroes at World Central Kitchen.

**Second Grade:** Our topic was Heroes and Bravery. We decided to create Messages of Hope Books to send to the heroes that are helping the Ukrainian refugees!



Day in Darkness - due to destruction, parts of Ukraine are now is darkness. To stand by those suffering, we spent a day without lights.






